ENTRY FEE

\$495.00 per team. Payable by cheque – entry granted to those who pay earliest (Waiting list afterwards)
Each Team is guaranteed two (2) games. 3 games if you make it to the Consolation or Championship game. Games are throughout the 4 days for ALL divisions
Preference will be given to those municipalities/teams providing their application and tournament fee first and as a group of 4 (Novice, Atom, PeeWee, Bantam). At that time teams will be put on a waiting list if they have not provided application and fees.

Important Clause:

No spots will be given or guaranteed, until completed roster sheets, and cheques are received by the Tournament Registrar. Each team roster will be on our Internet site: www.marchbreaktournament.com, and appear in our program.

Note: If your team is not selected, you will receive your full 100% payment back.

PLAYER, COACH & TRAINER ELIGIBILITY

All players, coaches, and trainers must be on approved roster sheets as per O.M.H.A. regulations. No pick-ups.

Under no circumstances will any select carded or select rostered teams or players be accepted in this tournament. Registration is open to regular House League roster teams only. Only O.M.H.A. roster sheets will be accepted. They must be approved. AP Players from a younger age group may be permitted – speak with Registrar for more details.

RULES #17 & #18 IN O.M.H.A. MANUAL OF OPERATIONS (PAGE 111)

17. Any O.M.H.A. House League team wishing to participate in a sanctioned tournament must have a Coach with a current NCCP Certification and a Trainer with current HTCP Certification registered to their team. No team shall play without either certified person. Teams will forfeit if this is not adhered to.

18. Local League teams who have paid an affiliation fee to the O.M.H.A. and who are otherwise eligible (residence rule) to enter O.M.H.A. competition shall be permitted, with the approval of their association, to play in sanctioned tournaments. These players must be properly approved on O.M.H.A. Roster Sheets of the current playing season.

GAME LENGTH

Each game will consist of three (3) 10 minute stop-time periods. No game can result in a tie.

VISITING TEAM

Designated on draw board outside tournament stats office as the top team.

HOME TEAM

Designated on draw board outside tournament stats office as the bottom team.

REGISTRATION

Coach or manager must submit O.M.H.A. approved player roster sheets. We require that you send your entry fee as soon as possible to ensure your acceptance into the tournament. We are going to accept applications from other local areas on a first-come first-served basis. In order for a team to be registered and guaranteed a spot, you must send your cheque AND your OMHA approved roster sheet. A cheque for \$495.00 must be sent in from each team for this tournament.

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1. Each team will be responsible for their own equipment. Arrangements to store equipment may be made upon request.
 2. Each player will receive an award and possibly a trophy depending on finish in tournament.

 5. Drinks will be supplied courtesy of the Newmarket Veterans Association after every game.

 7. You will note that we are requesting that each municipality to submit a minimum of 4 teams, one in each of the tournament's divisions. The reason for this is that there is a Municipality Trophy awarded to the municipality accumulating the most points throughout the tournament.

RULES

Player Eligibility: All players must be House League Players and duly carded as per O.M.H.A. regulations.

Number of Players: Each team may register and play a maximum of 17 players. Only players listed on the registration form may participate. Replacement or additions for any reason will not be accepted. All players expecting to play anytime during the tournament must be registered by team officials during first check in.

Schedule: All games will be played as scheduled. No deviations for any reason.

Length of Games: Each game will consist of three ten (10) minute stop time periods. No game can result in a tie, see below.

Penalties: All penalties assessed as per O.M.H.A. rules.

Tied Game: Should the score be tied at the end of regulation time, there will be an immediate sudden-victory overtime period. During the five-minute overtime period, the play will be stopped at the end of each one-minute interval. Each team will remove one player from the ice (substitution of players is allowed at any time) and a face-off will take place at the nearest face-off circle. A Penalty Shot will be awarded in lieu of a time penalty, whenever teams are reduced to three players or less (excluding goalkeepers) as a result of overtime procedure. However, the penalized player (excluding goalkeepers) will still be required to sit in the penalty box for what would have been the normal duration of the infraction called by the referee. Substitution will be allowed, by the team, for that player. If, at the end of the 1st overtime period, the tie has not been broken, successive overtime periods will result using the same format. Penalties incurred during regulation time will carry over as normal into the overtime period.

Visiting Team: Designated on the draw board outside the stats office as the Top Team

Home Team: Designated on the draw board outside the stats office as the Bottom Team. In cases of conflicting sweater colours, the team designated as the home team must change sweaters.

Registered Players: Must sign in at the registration desk at least one hour prior to their first game. Any player not signed on the tournament sheet, will be ineligible to play until they do so. Any player not signed in, but has played, will forfeit their teams wins. Dressing Rooms will be available. We ask that you clear them as soon as possible.

Disputes: If necessary, the Tournament Committee will arbitrate any dispute, and their decision will be accepted as binding. In addition, all rules and regulations as set out in the O.M.H.A. rule book will apply and all team members and officials will abide by them accordingly.

Mandatory Equipment: All O.M.H.A. rules regarding mandatory equipment will be enforced. This includes proper BNQ neck protectors, chin straps and mask straps that must be fastened at all times. The fois on goalkeepers' pads are illegal and will not be allowed.

Game Officials: All games will be officiated by officials registered with the Ontario Minor Hockey Association.

Special Notes:

1. Any Player incurring three (3) minor penalties of any kind within the same game, will be ejected for the remainder of the game.
2. Any Player or team official who receives any major for fighting or gross misconduct or match penalty will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
3. Any player or team official who receives a game misconduct in the third (3rd) period will be suspended for the next tournament game.
4. Body checking is not allowed. A penalty will be incurred for infraction of this rule.
5. Any player ejected from two (2) games, will be ejected from the tournament.
